



This is to address non-communicable diseases and in turn revive our culture and traditional foods. Fresh Foods Vanuatu has been in operation for about 6 months. It is run by Jester and his partner Stephanie, with family members being employed. They produce packaged frozen root crops such as cassava, taro and sweet potatoes. They pay for root crops from local farmers all around Vanuatu and sell locally with a vision to someday export their products overseas.
